FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS

Organizational Matters
Call to Order

This meeting was called to order at 1:49 p.m. and roll call was initiated. Board Members Bob Deahl, Michael Della Penta, Lane Gardner, and Zenzi Rogers were present, constituting a quorum. Others in attendance are listed above.

Public Comment Period

There were no questions or comments from the public.

Consideration of the Minutes of the September 4, 2014 Board of Supervisors Meeting

The Board reviewed the minutes of the September 4, 2014 Board of Supervisors Meeting. Mr. Haber stated that there was one minor update needed concerning the third order of

business. He stated that under his staff update on the third line there were some words missing. He stated the line should read "legal description for those areas should be ready soon." and the extra period at the end of the sentence should be removed.

On MOTION by Ms. Rogers, seconded by Mr. Gardner, with all in favor, the Board approved the minutes of the September 4, 2014 Board of Supervisors Meeting with the changes requested.

SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Davey
Tree
Performance/Termination

Ms. Cupps stated that she spoke with several board members and it was mentioned that there have been quite a few complaints with regards to the Davey Tree service. The Davey Tree service is provided for the board to review. Ms. Rogers stated that she has been having weekly meetings with Davey Tree since December. She has taken them to several different communities to show them what this community is looking for and not quite getting. Ms. Rogers also gave them a punch list of items that we would like to see completed and a timeframe to get those items done and that did not happen as requested. It seems the landscape is dying and the irrigation is a constant problem. Ms. Rogers sent a final email requesting that certain items be completed and those items were not completed.

Mr. Haber discussed that we probably have cause to terminate. The agreement provides 30 days notice without cause and immediate notice with cause. Another factor to keep in mind is that the contractor is entitled to compensation for work although subject to any claims or offsets the District may have against the contractor. Ms. Rogers stated that she would like to fire with cause. She also stated there are some areas of sod that died and she asked Davey Tree to replace them at their cost.

Ms. Cupps asked Ms. Ranchurejee if there are any outstanding payments due to Davey Tree. Ms. Ranchurejee replied that there are 2 outstanding invoices for Davey Tree – one is for \$6,917.00 and the other is for \$6,550.00.

Ms. Rogers stated that the replacement landscape company would be able to step in immediately.

Ms. Cupps stated the direction moving forward would be to terminate the Davey Tree contract with cause and grant Ms. Rogers the authority to determine what amount, if any, needs to be withheld and fixed by the new landscape company or give Davey Tree the opportunity to fix the items.

On MOTION by Mr. Gardner, seconded by Mr. Deahl, with all in favor, the Board approved the termination of the Davey Tree contract, with cause. Authority was granted to Ms. Rogers to determine what amount, if any, needs to be withheld from payment until the sod is replaced.

THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Landcare Group, Inc. Proposal

The board reviewed the proposal from Landcare Group, Inc. The total cost is \$154,680.00 a year and the previous contract with Davey Tree was \$154,104.00 a year. This puts the new bid at approximately \$500 over what the District was paying. Ms. Cupps stated that she is comfortable from a budget perspective. Ms. Cupps also pointed out that in the landscape improvement line item we will save some money as several items are running at a lower cost with the Landcare Group.

Ms. Rogers stated that there is a one-time charge of \$7,500.00 clean up that she wants to discuss with the Landcare Group, as she isn't sure it's necessary. Ms. Cupps stated that item was not in the budget and was not something Davey Tree was planning on doing and would be an overage.

Ms. Cupps brought up for discussion the mowing of the lake banks and wanted to know if that was included in the bid from the Landcare Group. Mr. Deahl said he thought it was included and that one of the ponds needed to be mowed. Ms. Rogers stated she is aware of the pond and they didn't focus on that area initially. Ms. Rogers stated she will verify that area is included in the bid or have it added.

Mr. Gardner asked Ms. Rogers if she thought the entire amount of the one-time cleanup fee of \$7,500 would need to be used or if there was a certain amount that would be needed to take care of some of the initial items that have been neglected. Ms. Rogers stated that the fungicide and insecticide would not be needed as that was done within the last few months. She also stated that the trim grasses off sidewalks item can be done

when they do the mowing and the clean all the weeds and vines in beds and de-boot palms may need half of what is listed. Ms. Rogers stated she didn't think more than \$3,000 would be needed to be spent for the one-time cleanup fee for the Landcare Group.

On MOTION by Mr. Gardner, seconded by Mr. Deahl, with all in favor, the Board approves the Landcare Group service agreement and granted the Chair authority to meet with the contractor and discuss one-time cleanup not to exceed \$3,000.00.

Ms. Rogers stated that Landcare will start on October 13th. Mr. Haber is going to draft an agreement for Landcare Group, Inc. with all exhibits referenced.

Mr. Gardner questioned if what was just approved needs to be amended to include authorizing staff to draft the agreement. Mr. Haber stated there can be a supplemental motion made.

On MOTION by Mr. Gardner, seconded by Mr. Deahl, with all in favor, the Board approved the Landcare Group service agreement proposal, subject to Counsel drafting an agreement with the proper attachments.

FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of FPL Street Light Agreement

Mr. Deahl discussed the FPL Street Light Agreement and how FPL would be coming in to put standard black fiberglass polls into the balance of Phase 1. Everything will be maintained by FPL and the District would pay the service fee to turn the lights on. Mr. Deahl also mentioned that once the agreement is signed it will take FPL 60-90 days to install the lights.

Ms. Rogers asked about FPL coverage for the existing homes that were just built, as there aren't many lights. Mr. Deahl stated that those areas are covered in this agreement.

On MOTION by Ms. Rogers, seconded by Mr. Della Penta, with all in favor, the Board approved the FPL Street Light Agreement.

FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Ratification of Funding Request 2014-12 & 2014-13

The Board reviewed Funding Request 2014-12 & 2014-13. Ms. Cupps stated both of these funding requests have been approved and funded. As already noted, we will be withholding payment to Davey Tree on 2014-13 until we have further authorization from Ms. Rogers.

On MOTION by Mr. Gartner, seconded by Ms. Rogers, with all in favor, the Board ratified Funding Request 2014-12 & 2014-13.

SIXTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Review of District Financial Statements

The Board reviewed the financial statements. There was no action required by the Board.

Ms. Rogers responded that those silt fences are to remain up right now but once they are removed that will be taken care of. Resolution 2015-02, Approving a Revised Budget for Fiscal Year 2014

RESOLUTION 2015-02

THE REVISED ANNUAL APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION OF THE SWEETWATER CREEK COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT (THE "DISTRICT") RELATING TO THE REVISED ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS AND ADOPTING THE REVISED BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2013, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2014

WHEREAS, the SWEETWATER CREEK Community Development District Board of Supervisors (the "Board") previously approved and adopted an annual budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2013 and ending September 30, 2014, pursuant to the provisions of Section 190.008(2)(a), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to revise the annual budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2013 and ending September 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Section 190.008(2)(a), Florida Statutes, requires that the District Board by passage of the Annual Appropriation Resolution shall adopt a budget for the each fiscal year and appropriate such sums of money as the Board deems necessary to defray all expenditures of the District during the ensuing fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the District Manager has prepared a Proposed Budget, whereby the Proposed Budget projects the cash receipts and disbursements anticipated during a given time period, including reserves for contingencies for emergency or other unanticipated expenditures during the fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE SWEETWATER CREEK COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT;

Section 1. Budget

- a. That the Board of Supervisors has reviewed the District Manager's Proposed Budgets, a copy of which is on file with the office of the District Manager and at the District's Records Office, and hereby approves certain amendments thereto, as shown in Section 2 below.
- b. That the District Manager's Proposed Budgets, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," are hereby adopted in accordance with the provisions of Section 190.008(2)(a), Florida Statutes, and incorporated herein by reference; provided, however, that the comparative figures contained in the adopted budget may be subsequently revised as deemed necessary by the District Manager to reflect actual revenues and expenditures for fiscal year 2013-2014.

c. That the adopted budget shall be maintained in the office of the District Manager and at the District's Records Office and identified as "The Revised Budget for the Sweetwater Creek Community Development District for the Fiscal Year Beginning October 1, 2013 and Ending September 30, 2014", as adopted by the Board of Supervisors on November 6, 2014.

Section 2. Appropriations

There is hereby appropriated out of the revenues of the Sweetwater Creek Community Development District, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2013, and ending September 30, 2014, the sum of money to be raised by the levy of assessments and otherwise, which sum is deemed by the Board of Supervisors to be necessary to defray all expenditures of the District during said budget year, to be divided and appropriated in the following fashion:

TOTAL GENERAL FUND \$353,626.53

TOTAL ALL FUNDS \$353,626.53

Section 3. Supplemental Appropriations

The Board may authorize by resolution, supplemental appropriations or revenue changes for any lawful purpose from funds on hand or estimated to be received within the fiscal year as follows:

- a. Board may authorize a transfer of the unexpended balance or portion thereof of any appropriation item.
- b. Board may authorize an appropriation from the unappropriated balance of any fund.
- c. Board may increase any revenue or income budget amount to reflect receipt of any additional unbudgeted monies and make the corresponding change to appropriations or the unappropriated balance.

The District Manager and Treasurer shall have the power within a given fund to authorize the transfer of any unexpected balance of any appropriation item or any portion thereof, provided such transfers do not exceed Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars or have the effect of causing more than 10% of the total appropriation of a given program or project to be transferred previously approved transfers included. Such transfer shall not have the effect of causing a more than \$10,000 or 10% increase, previously approved transfers included, to the original budget appropriation for the receiving program. Transfers within a program or project may be approved by the Board of Supervisors. The District Manager or Treasurer must establish administrative procedures which require information on the request forms proving that such transfer requests comply with this section.
